The dynamics of attachment and separation (Bowlby) Bar Hall is caregiver near, separation anxiety attentive and experiencing anxiety. responsive no distress and insecurity yes avoidance secure attachment experiencing a form of proximity seeking a experiencing security, amnesia, detachment viable option no love and confidence or indifference yes activated 'passive avoidant 'secure base behaviour' 'attachment behavlour' behavlour': inhibited playful, relaxed, smiling, visual monitoring of and emotional expression and less inhibited, sociable, attachment behaviours. protesting against exploration-oriented separation by caregiver, rejection of caregiver upon clinging, searching return, etc.
